In 2006, set career highs for catches (92), and receiving yards (1,295), leading the team in both categories, and earning his second Pro Bowl trip.

Selected as the Packers' 2006, 2005 and 2002 team MVP; also honored for his service to the community, winning awards such as the NFL's Walter Payton Man of the Year, Ed Block Courage Award, and the NFL Players Association's JB Award.

In 2005, set a new career highs and lead the team in catches (86), and receiving yards (1,221).

In 2005, Donald Driver Foundation events and fundraisers helped ten Houston-based families.

In 2004, tallied career highs in receptions (84), good for second on the club, and receiving yards (1,208), also second on club, while tying his previous season high in TD receptions (9) from 2002.

Overcoming countless obstacles growing up, Donald's experiences in life inspire him to be one of the Packers' most involved players in giving back to the community. In 2002, he and his wife created the **Donald Driver Foundation**. The foundation helps support homeless families as well as children's education through donations, various service projects, and social activities. Donald has made over 350 appearances since 1999—from schools to youth football fields to churches—delivering motivational speeches, assistance, and support.
